Calculating your requirements

First, calculate the cubic metres required. Simply multiply length x width x depth.

Example: A site has an area of 10m x 15m and needs a coverage of 150mm, $10 \times 15 \times 0.15 = 22.5m^3$

Then, once you know the cubic metres, simply divide it by:

1 for bulk bags of Blended Loam™ Topsoil
22.5 divided by 1 = 23 bulk bags

1.1 for loose Blended Loam™ Topsoil
22.5 divided by 1.1 = 21 tonnes

1 for bulk bags of Beds & Borders Topsoil
22.5 divided by 1 = 23 bulk bags

0.73 for bulk bags of Screened Loam Topsoil
22.5 divided by 0.73 = 31 bulk bags

0.67 for loose Screened Loam Topsoil
22.5 divided by 0.67 = 34 tonnes

1 for bulk bags of Vegetable & Fruit Topsoil
22.5 divided by 1 = 23 bulk bags

0.73 for bulk bags of Turf & Lawn Seeding Topsoil
22.5 divided by 0.73 = 31 bulk bags

Rolawn Lawn Topdressing is a high quality, sand based, multi-purpose lawn dressing, designed for use on Rolawn lawns. It can also be used to improve any utility lawn. Applying Rolawn Lawn Topdressing will help to enhance a lawn's appearance. It will help stimulate new grass growth, create a level surface, improve drainage and control the build up of thatch.

- Mix of 85% sand and 15% silt/clay
- Friable - easy to apply and incorporate into a lawn

When to apply Rolawn Lawn Topdressing

Rolawn Lawn Topdressing can be applied anytime, when the grass is actively growing.

Spring & Autumn - application of up to 3 litres/m² (approx. 4kg/m² or 3mm deep) of topdressing will assist in levelling, repairing worn and patchy areas, improving drainage, minimising thatch and promoting growth. If required, it should be done in conjunction with:-

- Scarification
- Hollow tining/forking
- Fertilising
- Overseeding

Summer - application of up to 1.5 litres/m² (approx. 2kg/m² or 1.5mm deep) of topdressing will assist in routine maintenance as worn areas appear. If required, it should be done in conjunction with:-

- Hollow tining/forking
- Fertilising

NB. If drought conditions exist, do not apply topdressing, fertiliser or hollow tine/fork the area.

Bark

Selecting the right bark

There are many different grades of bark. Some are specialist and others are suited for a variety of applications. It is important to choose the right bark for your project.

Rolawn barks are of a consistent high quality. They will inhibit weed development, reducing ongoing maintenance, improve moisture retention, reducing the need for irrigation and act as an insulation for plant roots, reducing plant loss in cold weather.

Rolawn Landscaping Bark

Rolawn Landscaping Bark is a mid-dark brown, multi-purpose grade bark derived from forestry woodchip. It is a natural product and will enhance the appearance of landscaping projects.



Rolawn Play Grade Bark

Rolawn Play Grade Bark is a quality, reddish brown, pine bark, which is ideal for use in children's play areas. It is tested to BSEN1177:1998 regarding impact absorption.



Rolawn Decorative Bark

Rolawn Decorative Bark is a quality, durable, golden brown deluxe ornamental pine bark. Its attractive appearance and shape make it ideal for beds and borders.

Seasonal lawn maintenance

January/February

- Remove leaves and debris
- Mower servicing and sharpening
- Stay off the lawn if frozen or waterlogged



March/April

- Start mowing the lawn as warmer weather stimulates turf growth and increase the frequency of mowing as required
- Apply Rolawn Lawn Topdressing
- Remove by hand or spot treat coarse grasses and weeds
- Scarify if the lawn is more than 12 months old
- Feed with Rolawn GroRight® Spring Lawn Food
- Patch damaged lawn areas and edges with Rolawn turf or Rolawn lawn seed
- Over seed if the lawn is more than 12 months old with Rolawn lawn seed



May/June

- Increase mowing frequency, a little and often is the key
- Aerate
- Remove by hand or spot treat coarse grasses and weeds
- Water if rainfall is low



July/August

- Use water wisely, but to maintain colour in summer, more watering will probably be required. In times of drought your Rolawn lawn will go brown and dormant. It will recover when rainfall returns
- Apply a Chafer Grub Killer and Leatherjacket Killer if required
- Make arrangements for your lawn to be mown whilst you are on holiday



September/October

- Gradually decrease mowing frequency as grass growth slows, raise the height of cut as winter approaches
- Scarify if the lawn is more than 12 months old
- Aerate
- Feed with Rolawn GroRight® Autumn Lawn Food
- Repair damaged or worn areas with new Rolawn turf or Rolawn lawn seed
- Repair damaged or worn areas with new
- Apply Rolawn Lawn Topdressing
- Allow worm casts to dry before brushing with a stiff broom



November/December

- Remove leaves and debris
- Mow if the lawn is still growing
- Prune and thin foliage surrounding the lawn
- Clean and oil all equipment before putting into winter storage

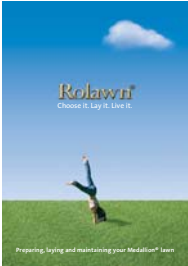
